Ms. Carder began working for SCUREF in 1997 based out of the Office of Special Programs at the Medical University of South Carolina. During this period, she helped manage a graduate fellowship and an undergraduate scholarship in nuclear science and engineering. She is currently the Program Coordinator for multiple SCUREF federal educational programs ranging from a naval reactor development program (Rickover Fellowships) to logistics for scientific boards. Ms. Carder is now based out of the University of South Carolina Aiken, Sponsored Research Charleston Office.

Ms. Carder specializes in meeting and event planning. For over 15 years, she has assisted the Nuclear Energy Advisory Committee with their meeting planning in Washington, DC and various locations throughout the United States.
