Mr. Williamson has been involved in supporting science and engineering education and research programs for over thirty-five years. He has conducted several workforce studies in nuclear science and engineering, which have led to federal support in nuclear engineering, health physics, and radiochemistry. In this regard, he has developed and managed undergraduate research, graduate fellowships, junior faculty, faculty research and institutional programs promoting the enhancement of science and engineering at universities throughout the United States.

Mr. Williamson became the Chief Operating Officer at SCUREF in 2001, and since that time has led SCUREF into becoming one of the leading organizations in the management of nuclear security research and education programs. SCUREF supports educational activities related to the development of reactors in aircraft carriers and submarines for the Nuclear Navy; supports the development and maintenance of higher education programs in nuclear forensics; and has established programs in nuclear nonproliferation and international safeguards at U.S. universities.

Mr. Williamson has promoted a strong working relationship between SCUREF member institutions and the Savannah River Site, and in some cases, other national research and development facilities, as he works closely with the nuclear programs at Clemson University, the University of South Carolina, and South Carolina State University. Mr. Williamson holds a B.A. degree in Public Administration, and an M.A. in Political Science from the University of Tennessee.
